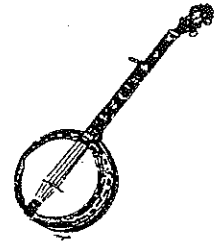

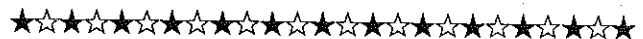

Doris and Terri have had their debut, but their first real gig will be February 9, at the John's Hopkins University Coffee House at 7:30PM.

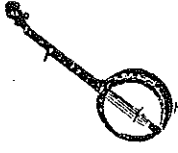

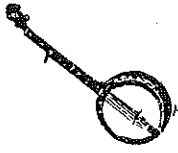
